# **Privacy Policy**

Prudence Foundation ("we", "our", "us") takes the privacy and protection of your personal data seriously. We are the data controller for personal data collected in connection with your use of Levela (the "Platform"). We are established in Hong Kong with a registered address at 13th Floor, One International Finance Centre, 1 Harbour View Street, Central, Hong Kong.

This Privacy Policy sets out the basis on which we will process any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, in connection with your use of the Platform.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully so that you understand your rights and how we will collect, use, and process your personal data. This Privacy Policy supplements any other privacy-related notices and policies we may provide to you from time to time and is not intended to override them. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy, you should not use the Platform or otherwise provide your information to us.

For ease of reference, here is a summary of the information contained in this Privacy Policy.

## • Who does this Privacy Policy apply to?

This Privacy Policy applies to any user of the Platform. The Platform is intended for users aged 16 and older. If you are under the age of legal majority in your jurisdiction (e.g., under 18), your parent or legal guardian must agree to this Privacy Policy on your behalf.

## • What information do we collect and why?

We collect information you provide during registration, such as your name, email address, age, gender, and country, to set up and manage your account. We also collect data about your usage of the Platform, such as your progress through learning modules and quiz results, to provide our services, track your progress, and improve our offerings.

## • Who do we share your information with?

Your information may be shared with our affiliates and selected third-party service providers who support the operation of the Platform (e.g., cloud hosting). We may also be required by law or a court order to disclose certain information.

### • Where do we store your information and for how long?

Your information is stored in Singapore. Our support and technical teams may access your information from our offices around the world to support the Platform's operation. We will retain your information for as long as you maintain an account with us, or until you choose to permanently delete it.

# • What rights do I have over my information?

Depending on your location, you may have certain rights regarding your personal data, such

as rights of access, correction, deletion, or the right to object to our processing of your information.

#### WHO WE SHARE YOUR INFORMATION WITH

We may share your personal data with:

- **Companies within our corporate group** who help operate the Platform.
- Third-party service providers who process data on our behalf, such as cloud and data hosting providers. These providers may only use your data in accordance with our instructions and this Privacy Policy.
- Legal, regulatory, or judicial authorities where we are legally required to disclose information, to comply with the law, to protect the safety and security of our users and the public, or to enforce our legal rights.
- Third parties in connection with a business transaction, such as a merger, sale of assets, or bankruptcy.

### WHERE WE STORE YOUR INFORMATION

The personal data we collect from you will be stored in Singapore. Our support and technical teams are located in our and/or our affiliates' offices around the world and may have access to your information to support the Platform. We take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your personal data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and applicable data protection laws.

### **SECURITY**

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data. However, no transmission of information via the internet is completely secure. While we do our best to protect your data, we cannot guarantee its security, and any transmission is at your own risk.

### **YOUR RIGHTS**

Depending on the laws of your jurisdiction, you may have the following rights in relation to your personal data:

- Access: The right to access the personal data we hold about you.
- **Correction:** The right to correct any of your personal data we hold that is inaccurate.
- **Erasure (Deletion):** The right to request the deletion of your personal data in certain circumstances.
- **Portability:** The right to receive a copy of your personal data and to have it transferred to a third party in certain circumstances.
- **Objection:** The right to object to our processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.
- **Restriction of Processing:** The right to require us to stop processing your personal data, other than for storage, in certain circumstances.
- Withdrawal of Consent: Where we rely on consent, you have the right to withdraw it at any time.
